Black History Month:
Camden Intermediate School celebrates Moses Grandy.
Moses Grandy was an African-American author, abolitionist, and, for more than the first four decades of his life, an enslaved person. Grandy helped build the Great Dismal Swamp Canal and learned how to navigate boats. It was that skill that led him to be made commander of several boats that traveled the canal and Pasquotank River, transporting merchandise from Elizabeth City, North Carolina to Norfolk, Virginia. Upon his freedom, Grandy published the autobiography, Narrative of the Life of Moses Grandy, Late a Slave in the United States of America, in 1843. It was one of slave narratives read in the United States and overseas that fueled the abolitionist movement.
