Kindergarten Registration - Camden County Residents

All children who were born on or before August 31, 2013 are eligible for Kindergarten registration for the upcoming 2018-2019 school year. Please register your child during these dates.

Pre-Registration for 2018-2019 Kindergarten students will be held at Grandy Primary School on:



Monday, March 26th from noon to 6 p.m.
Tuesday, March 27th from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
Monday, April 16th from noon to 6 p.m.
Tuesday, April 17th from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Please have your child with you. There will be brief screenings provided by a Kindergarten teacher and a speech pathologist. This process will take approximately 45 minutes, so please plan your time accordingly.

Documents Needed to Complete Registration:

- The student's certified birth certificate (not a copy or the "mother's record")
- The student's current shot record
- The student's social security card
- If the birth parents that are named on the birth certification do not reside at the same address, a copy of the custody order is required.
- The homeowner's lease, deed, mortgage, rent receipt or a letter from the property owner verifying the
- Two (2) current utility bills (less than 30 days old)
- A valid NC driver's license with the current address (or receipt from DMV indicating the change has been made), NC state ID with the same address OR a valid military ID.

For shared housing, all residency documents must be provided by the homeowner and the enrolling parent must have their driver's license with the same address or military ID.
